









Day Camp registration is now open. Each camp offers a variety of activities geared towards specific ages.

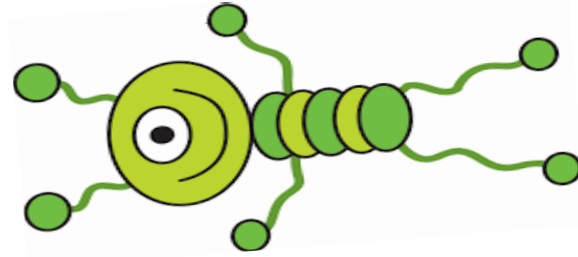
The cost is \$10.00 per child per camp.
